Be a Host Family:

Help medical students understand the experiences of families of children with disabilities by participating in the Seminar on Family Centered Care and Developmental Disabilities at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School.

Your role as a **host family** includes:

- Meeting with a small group of medical students either in your home over dinner or by Zoom
- Sharing your families' experiences raising a child with a disability and interacting with health professionals
- Contributing to the education of future medical professionals

Host families will receive a \$100 stipend for each group of students they meet with through support from the New Jersey Council on Developmental Disabilities.

About the Seminar:



The seminar is held 6-8 times per year.



Families can host as often as they want, usually 2-4 times per year.



Most visits last about 2-3 hours. Start and end timing are flexible.



All members of the family are welcome to participate.
